ORDER

The District Nadaswara Takil Thozhilali Associat bing Palakkad has submitted a representation dated 17.12.1994 to the Kerala State Commission for Backward Classes requesting that the 'Caste' "Melakkarar" be included in the Scheduled Castes or atleasa in the Other Backward Classes for the purpose of employment reservation. It was stated in the representation that Melakkarar, Isai, Vellalar and Chavalakkaran are one and the same that Melakkarar has been included in the Other Backward Classes list only for Educat. and Concessions, that Melakkarar and Isai Vellalar are not seen in the Other Backward Classes list for employment reservation, that members of the community are musicians who play on Nadaswara, Takil etc. The Commission has asked the Ananthakrishna Iyer International Centre for Anthropological Studies (AICAS), Palakkadu to undertake study on the request or the Association. After detailed study of the issue the Cent has submitted its report to the Commission.

The Commission examined the witnesses and documen produced by the Association, the evidence tendered by the representatives of the Association as witnesses during the hearings as well as the Study Report of the AICAS.

hecording to the AICAS report the Community tradihally engaged in playing Nadaswaram etc. consists of the
following endogamous communities namely, Chavalakkaran, Ocha
Vidurarayar and Isai Vellalar, 'Melakkaran', is a term used
generically to include all these communities. After detailed
examination of the request of the Association, the Commission
found that the hastory of the community began from Tanilnadu.
The community was considered as depressed and their tradition
occupation was fishing which was considered as low and pullu-

But after settling in Kerala they succeeded in getting higher social status with only limited polluting impact, temple musicians their social status improved. The Communis backward from the educational point of view and for this reason finds a place in the Other Backward Classes list for educational concessions. According to the Commission the evidence in this case does not support the view that Melakkarar are so backward as to deserve reservation in terms of Article 16 (4) of the Constitution. The Commission advised Government under section 9 (1) of the Kerala State Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1993 that the Melakkar need not be included in the State Other Backward Classes II for reservation in public service.

Government after due consideration of the advice of the Commission order that the advice of the Commission above mentioned be accepted and they order accordingly.
