


Expression of Interest

KIRTADS, as part of its Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS), intend to produce visual ethnography/anthropological documentary on five Scheduled Tribal communities of Wayanad viz, Adiya, Paniya, Kattunayikkan, Aranadar, and Mullukurumba. Expressions of interests are invited from Electronic Media expert and Anthropologist, for providing training to the five candidates selected from ST communities in digital film making. Electronic Media expert should be a post Graduate in Electronic media with minimum three documentaries broad casted in reputed channel in his/her credit. Selected electronic media expert needs to provide training with their own equipment (both pre-production and post-production). Application form and other specification in this regard are appended in the website (<https://kirtads.kerala.gov.in>). Remuneration for the faculties will be in the form of honorarium as per the rules admissible by the Kerala Government. Those interested should submit the financial budget for hiring equipments for post and preproduction works along with the application.

The anthropologist needs to be a post graduate in anthropology with two years Research and documentation experience in Scheduled Tribe or related area. Both Anthropologist and Electronic Media expert should accompany the Trainers in the field. Accommodation and refreshment in this regard will be provided by the institute. Duration of the project will be six month from October 2019 to March 2020, as per the MoU signed by the institution and the party. Interested candidates are requested to forwarded the duly filled application form to the Director, KIRTADS on or before 20/09/2019, with envelop superscribed 'Visual Ethnography of ST-Communities in Kerala Anthropologist of Electronic Media Expert, respectively.
